You are invited to attend a meeting of the Zeta Chi Unit of the National Association of Parliamentarians (NAP). We meet to study *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised* and improve our parliamentary skills in a relaxed setting. We have a lot of fun while we learn and we welcome your participation.

We meet at 7:15 p.m. on the third Monday of each month (except June and December) in the Topping Room at Foster Library in Ventura. Each meeting consists of a lesson followed by a brief business session. Our members plan the lesson schedule and take turns preparing and presenting the lessons.

Our lessons can be geared to help provisional members pass our national association's examination of basic parliamentary knowledge. You would be eligible for membership in our State and National associations upon passing the examination.

Higher membership classifications, called *Registered Parliamentarian* and *Professional Registered Parliamentarian*, are available to those who wish to pursue them.

If you would enjoy expanded association participation, Zeta Chi is part of the Southern Area of our State association. Area meetings, held four Saturdays a year, consist of a lesson, luncheon, brief business meeting, and a problem clinic. Our State association meets annually, in the fall, for 2½ days of workshops and business. California is part of a multi-state district which meets biannually, usually in May, for two days of workshops. Our National association has a biannual 3-day convention, of workshops and business, in the fall.
